WELCOME TO AFRICA

15 September 2016

Upon your arrival at OR Tambo International Airport you will be warmly welcomed off your arrival aircraft and assisted with passport control, luggage collection and taken to the Arrivals Terminal where you will be met by an &Beyond team member who will deliver your personalised travel journal. Your golf clubs will be taken from you for delivery to Jock Safari Lodge and you will be transferred by coach to Peermont D'Oreale Grande Hotel.

Enjoy 1 night at Peermont D'Oreale Grande Hotel at Emperors Palace in a classic room with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes breakfast.

18h00 - A short Welcome Cocktail Party and Briefing has been arranged to introduce you to the other tour participants and familiarise you with timing and logistics of the tour.

16 September 2016

You will be transferred from Peermont D'Oreale Grande Hotel to OR Tambo International Airport for your private charter flight to Skukuza Airport. Approximately 1hr 15 minute flight.

Here you will be collected and will be transferred by road (1 hour) to Jock Safari Lodge.

Enjoy 3 nights at Jock Safari Lodge in a luxury suite with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes all meals, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, high tea, game drives, guided walks. Your golf clubs will be delivered by road to Jock.

18 September 2016

Today you will play a round of golf at the No.1 rated course in South Africa, Leopard Creek Golf Club. Share the water hazards with hippos and crocodiles whilst warthog, impala, baboons etc join you on the fairways. Non-golfers will remain at the Lodge and continue their Safari experiences.

19 September 2016

You will be collected from Jock Safari Main Lodge and transferred to Skukuza Airport for your private charter flight to Phinda Mountain Lodge.

Enjoy 3 nights at &Beyond Phinda Mountain Lodge in a suite with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, scheduled safari activities, refreshments on game drives, nature walks (1 hour) accompanied by experienced armed trackers (subject to availability), emergency medical evacuation insurance and laundry.

You will be collected at &Beyond Phinda Mountain Lodge and driven by coach to Zimbali Lodge, approximately 3.5 hour drive.

Golf is booked at the Montagu Course at Fancourt. Non-golfers have a spa option and then time to enjoy the delights of Fancourt with their partners after the completion of golf early afternoon.

27 September 2016

This day golf at Pezula Golf Club has been arranged. Non-golfers will travel with the golfers and continue along the Garden Route to Knysna (Birds of Eden - World's largest undercover bird sanctuary, Monkeyland etc) and surrounding areas.

28 September 2016

You will be collected by coach from Fancourt Hotel and transferred to the Cape Grace Hotel. (5.5 hour drive)

Enjoy 4 nights at Cape Grace Hotel in a luxury room with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes breakfast, use of the Hot Spa area (steam room, sauna, rain and body shower), complimentary limited wireless internet access, morning tea and coffee with wake-up calls, luxury chauffeur transfers within the City Bowl (10km radius) including Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens from 07h00 to 23h00, subject to availability and Cape Wine Orientation (Introduction to Wines of the Cape).

Indulge in a full day in the spectacular Cape Winelands. The estates visited will vary according to your preferences, but the tour includes the region's major wine producing areas and visits some beautiful wine estates for tastings of high quality vintages. Nestled in a valley where the French Huguenots settled in 1688, Franschhoek is a delight for antique lovers and gastronomes (the town boasts some world-famous eateries). South Africa's second-oldest town, Stellenbosch provides another glimpse of classic 17th and 18th century Cape style, with a chance to browse quaint Dorp Street, visit the museum or explore the many galleries and shops of this university town.

30 September 2016

Free day to enjoy the sights and sounds of Cape Town

01 October 2016

You will be collected at 09h00 for your Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour, including entrance fees but excluding lunch.

This full-day tour takes in the scenic highlights of the Cape Peninsula, beginning with the four secluded beaches of Clifton, as well as the sidewalk cafés and bars of trendy Camp's Bay. The next stop is the spectacular coastal suburb of Hout Bay, a former fishing village with a long, sandy beach facing a bay framed by the mountains. Explore the restaurants, shops and markets of Mariner's Wharf, a harbour-front emporium with a distinct maritime ambiance. Depending on whether the road is open, the tour will continue along the breath-taking Chapman's Peak Drive before heading to the Cape of Good Hope to explore the nature reserve, see the Diaz Cross and perhaps even indulge in lunch at a local restaurant. From here you will travel to Simon's Town, famous for its naval military base, and then visit the charming penguin colony at Boulders Beach. The tour ends at the beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, set against the eastern slopes of spectacular Table Mountain.

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Renowned the world over, this massive reserve stretches 350 km (220 miles) from north to south and is 60 km (40 miles) in breadth. Home to the Big Five, as well as 510 bird, 147 mammal, 114 reptile, 49 fish and 34 amphibian species, the park is as wild today as the Africa of old. A true nature lover, in 1898 President Paul Kruger managed - despite fierce opposition - to obtain an area that could be set aside for the purposes of conservation. Known as the Sabie Game Reserve, local police were responsible for protecting game. They were not successful, though, and, in 1902, Major James Stevenson-Hamilton was appointed warden. A long struggle between hunters and Stevenson-Hamilton ensued and it was only in 1926, when the National Parks Act was passed, that Sabie was renamed and became a safe haven for wildlife.



THE SPIRIT OF JOCK SAFARI LODGE

Nestled at the confluence of the Mitomeni and Biyamiti Rivers is the beautiful **Jock Safari Lodge**. Here, guests can enjoy spectacular views, lovely accommodation and exciting wildlife encounters.
